Swachhta Pakhwada, 16-31 October, 2016.

KVK Poonch working under the patronage of Directorate of Extension, SKUAST-Jammu on the behest of Prime Minister of India celebrated the Swachta Pakhwada from 16-31 Oct. 2016. The fortnightly programme was celebrated under the following headings.

Pledge Ceremony

On 16th October, all the staff members of KVK Poonch along the staff members of Maize Breeding Research Sub-Station (MBRSS) took the Swachta Pledge to keep the office premises clean and committed to ventilate the message of Swachh Bharat Mission to many more. Unanimously all agreed and decided to conduct some events during this Pakhwada to promote the awareness on Swachh Bharat Mission.

2. Awareness campaign

In order to make the Swachta Pakhwada a grand event, a successful campaign was conducted in the office premises and vicinity areas. The campaign was organized on 17 and 18 October 2016 to create mass awareness about cleaning. 3. Special campus cleaning drive

It was entrusted upon all the participants to desist from burning the biodegradable wastes, instead they should be used in making the compost which serves as the best organic manure.

4. Speech competition

In order to further disseminate the message of Swachta Pakhwada, a speech competition involving the students of Govt. Boys Higher Secondary School on 25.10.2016 and Govt. Girls Higher Secondary School Poonch was conducted in the main Hall of KVK Poonch on 26.10.2016 under the title “**My Environment My role**” Many boys and girls expressed their views in order to make the environment clean, spotless and hygienic. A threadbare discussion

was carried out in which the students raised various queries and means of utilization and recycling of different types wastes.

5. Plantation drive

Two days plantation drive was organized on 27 & 28 .10.2016 with a purpose of encouraging the farmers to plant perennial grasses especially Napier in the waste lands which will serve the twin objectives of eradicating the deadliest parthenium weed besides meeting the fodder demands in the area.
